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Requirements	Classroom Conduct and Rules
1. Enrolled Students must be 15 years of age by the start of the first class. 2. Students may not miss more than three classes. 3. If a student misses more than three classes, they will be required to retake the course in its entirety. 4. All enrolled students must obtain a Washington State Learner's Permit and have it in their possession for every behind-the-wheel drive. 5. In order to join a class, the student must join before the third class. 6. There is a required 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel drives that must be completed before students may complete the course. 7. The course is not possible to complete in less than four weeks. 8. The course must be completed within twenty weeks.	1. The student enrollment form must be completed and signed by both the student and their parent before the end of the first class. All forms must be filled in with full legal name. 2. All classes must be completed or made up before the final written exam can be taken. 3. Classroom disruptions will not be tolerated. Students will be asked to leave and will have to make up the class period. This includes but is not limited to; a. Disrespect of school employees b. Excessive use of cellphone in class c. Altercations with other students. 4. Cheating will result in immediate expulsion from the course without a refund. 5. South Sound Driving School has a zero tolerance drug policy. Any student that comes to a class or a behind-the-wheel drive under the influence of any drug will be immediately dismissed from the course without refund.
Behind-the-Wheel Drives	Payment and Refund Policy
1. 48 hours of notice is required to cancel or reschedule all behind-the-wheel drives. Failure to show up to the drive appointment or cancel within 48 hours notice will result in a \$30.00 fee. Showing up without an instruction permit will be treated the same as not showing up. 2. If inclement weather causes drives to be canceled for safety reasons, parents and students will be notified promptly and the drive will be rescheduled. 3. Additional drives may be purchased for \$45 an hour. If the requirements for behind-the-wheel drives cannot be completed in 6 hours, additional drives may be required at a rate of \$45 per hour. Parents will be notified by the start of the student's 4th drive if additional drives are required. 4. All drives will be recorded using a two-camera dash cam that is attached to the front windshield. This is for student and instructor safety. No footage will be used as classroom examples where the student is visible.	1. The regularly priced course is \$600 and can change at any time without notice. There may be some other incentives to lower tuition. 2. Tuition will not be refunded unless the student drops the course before the first day of class. Payment may be put towards a future class date. 3. A \$50 deposit will be required to hold your spot in the class. This payment must be paid upon registration. 4. Payment plans will be accepted on a case by case basis. 5. Completion of the course will not be reported to the Department of Licensing until tuition and any incurred fees are paid in full. 6. A student who must retake the course because of too much elapsed time or they missed more than three class periods will be offered to retake the entire course at half price.

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Washington State Intermediate Driver License Information

- Must be 16 years old and held an instruction permit for at least 6 months.
- Must have 50 hours of behind the wheel driving with somebody with 5 years of licensed experience.
 - 10 must be night driving
- Must not have committed any traffic violations within 6 months of license application.
- No alcohol or other drug convictions while holding an instruction permit.
- People under the age of 18 will be issued an Intermediate Driver License.
- During the first six months of having the license, an intermediate license holder may not drive anyone under the age of 20, except immediate family members. (spouse, child, stepchild, or siblings, both by birth and marriage).
- After the initial six months, they may not drive with more than 3 people under the age of 20 who are not immediate family members.
- Intermediate Driver License holders may not drive between the hours of 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM
 - There are exceptions for farm/ agricultural work. (RCW 46.20.070)
- No cell phone use at all. No hands-free device allowed either.
 - Reporting an emergency is the only legal reason to use a wireless device.
- Failure to follow these laws will result in license suspension, warning letters sent home, or fines.

How to Get Your Permit

How to get an instruction permit

1. If you don't already have a WA ID card, pre-apply online to save time in the office (some restrictions may apply). <https://www.dol.wa.gov/driverslicense/preapply.html>
2. Finish your application at an office. See Tips for visiting an office: Driver licensing offices.
 - If you're taking a driver training course, be sure to do this 1-10 days before you start the course.
 - You need to bring proof of identity.
 - Under 18 years old
 - Your parents must provide proof of their identity and relationship to you. Bring a parent with you to sign the parental authorization form.
 - If you can't bring a parent, have them fill out the Parental Authorization Affidavit form, have it notarized, and bring it with you to the office.
 - The DOL will need to have a social security number on file if you want to get your license issued online. Make sure you add your social security number to your record when we issue your permit.
